



PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION NOTICE

URIIS 2026 – Innovation POC Challenge

2. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

We may collect personal data including but not limited to:

- Full name
- Designation
- Company name
- Company registration details
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Business address
- Professional profile information
- Submitted corporate problem statements
- Event attendance records
- Images, audio or video recordings captured during Programme sessions
- Any other information voluntarily provided

3. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING

Personal data is processed for the following purposes:

- Registration and evaluation of corporate problem statements
- Programme administration and coordination
- Selection and shortlisting of Corporate Problem Owners
- Matching with startups, technology companies and researchers
- Communication regarding Programme logistics
- Reporting to URIIS 2026 organising committee and relevant government stakeholders
- Audit, compliance and record-keeping requirements
- Post-event follow-up relating to POC, pilot or collaboration discussions
- Post-event follow-up relating to POC, pilot or collaboration discussions

4. DATA SHARING & DISCLOSURE

Personal data may be shared with:

- URIIS 2026 Organising Committee
- Evaluation panel members
- Relevant government agencies associated with URIIS 2026
- Contracted service providers strictly on a need-to-know basis
- Technology or platform providers supporting Programme operations

Where sharing occurs, it will be limited to data reasonably necessary for Programme purposes.

Sensitive personal data will not be disclosed without explicit consent unless required by law.

5. CORPORATE PROBLEM STATEMENT INFORMATION

Corporate problem statements submitted may be shared with:

- Startups
- Technology companies
- University researchers
- Approved innovation partners

Such sharing is limited to Programme purposes and subject to evaluation framework guidelines.

Corporate representatives are responsible for ensuring that no confidential or classified information is disclosed unless separately protected by a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA).

6. DATA RETENTION

Personal data will be retained for:

- Duration of URIIS 2026 Programme; and
- Up to 36 months thereafter for reporting, audit and collaboration follow-up purposes

Thereafter, data will be securely deleted or anonymised unless retention is required by law.

7. DATA SECURITY

Kolaxus implements reasonable administrative, organisational and technical safeguards including:

- Access control restrictions
- Confidentiality obligations
- Secure cloud storage
- Controlled internal access to Programme data

8. YOUR RIGHTS UNDER PDPA

You have the right to:

- Request access to your personal data
- Request correction of inaccurate data
- Withdraw consent (subject to legal or contractual limitations)
- Restrict certain processing activities
- Lodge a complaint with the Department of Personal Data Protection (JPDP)

9. CROSS-BORDER TRANSFER

Where data is stored or processed outside Malaysia, Kolaxus ensures appropriate contractual or equivalent safeguards are in place in compliance with PDPA.

10. DATA BREACH RESPONSE

In the event of a data breach posing significant risk, Kolaxus will take appropriate mitigation steps and notify affected individuals and relevant authorities in accordance with applicable laws.
